The topics include the functions of a patrol officer, the use of force, the role of the Internal Affairs Unit, tactical units, and the investigation of crimes.

Our objective is to give a general understanding of the various operations of our profession and how we carry out our duties. We hope a better understanding of how **your police department** works will improve the relationship between citizens and officers.

The Citizen Police Academy meets once a week for ten consecutive weeks. Participants must be at least 21 years of age and have a form of identification.

The Citizen Police Academy is free.
